# 1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the college:

Kalimpong College was accredited by NAAC in 2007 with 'B' Grade and the second cycle in 2016 with 'B++' Grade with CGPA 2.79.

The goal of Kalimpong College is 'Quality education, access and equality'. In order to achieve the goal of quality education, the college has taken initiatives in providing the latest technological apparatus to the faculty and students. In this endeavor smart class room with smart board, free internet access, white and green board, INFLIBNET, LCD projector, OPH and other ICT facilities have been provided for the stakeholders. In order to achieve the goal of access to education for the financially underprivileged students the college has arranged free ship, half free ship, scholarship, distribution of books and study materials to them. The online admission procedure fulfills the goal of equality to all sections of students without discriminating caste, creed, religion, geographical distance, etc.

The basic objectives of the college are:

- i). To spread higher education to the stakeholders belonging to below poverty line groups, women, schedule caste, schedule tribe and minorities with minimum cost possible.
  - ii). To achieve excellence along with the goals of excess and equity.

#### 3. Innovations in Curricular Design and Transactions:

Kalimpong College is affiliated under North Bengal University. The college has to abide by the curriculum designed by the university. The curriculum are framed by the Board of Studies of respective disciplines which have to be approved by the Under Graduate Council and finally by the Executive Council of the North Bengal University. However, at times some teachers take active participation in framing the syllabi of the degree level as members of the Board and Under Graduate Council and the Court. There are instances when our institution has brought to the notice of the Vice Chancellor the problems faced by the faculty members and the students relating to the curriculum.

Office of the Principal is totally computerized with internet, Wi-Fi, fax, Xerox, printer. Online admission process is followed according to the rules and regulations of the Department of Higher Education, W.B. The examination is conducted by the North Bengal University and the result is also published by them. There is a system of viewing the examination result online in the College campus. Filling up of the forms for BA, B.Sc., B.Com and BBA examination and distribution of admit cards are totally on e-mode. The students enjoy online access regarding their admission and examination. Certificate to the students are issued by the University and the same are distributed to the students by the College.

There is no provision of routine health care service system in the institution, but each year the Zoology department conducts Blood Grouping, Blood pressure Check-up, Colour-blindness check-up for the students and the staff. The college has a sick room with two beds and first-aid facilities. In case of emergency, the trained NCC and NSS students extend their help in carrying the sick/patient to the hospital/clinic. The female teachers organized interactive discussion session on hygiene and proper sanitation with female students.

#### 34. Performance in Sports:

The college was semi-finalist in Inter-College Volley-ball (Men's) Competition organized by North Bengal University in 2016-2017.

#### 35. Incentives to Outstanding Sportsperson:

The college bears the cost of registration fee, purchase of sports equipments, materials, TA and DA to all participating students and staff. The winners are felicitated with trophy and certificate either individually or in group as the case may be during large gathering, particularly

on the Fresher's Welcome Programme. The outstanding sports personalities enjoy the facilities like free ship, half free ship and some token money. The loss of classes of the participating students is compensated by taking additional classes by the concerned subject teachers. The participating sports students get relaxation in counting attendance, unit test, class test, sent up test, etc.
