

- 2.4 The ETCPL shall provide in advance very clear information to students (in writing or displayed in notice board) as well as college website regarding any ongoing training programs/workshops/internships/interviews and all future programs (if any).
- 2.5 ETCPL shall be responsible in solving any issues relating to training and any other concerns within a reasonable timeframe agreed upon by ETCPL and Kalimpong College.

3.0 ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES OF KALIMPONG COLLEGE.

- 3.1 Kalimpong College shall assist ETCPL for inviting applications from ellege candidates and screening of the applications of the students of kalimpong college received through Career Guidance & Placement Cell, kalimpong college.
- 3.2 Kalimpong College shall notify and invite applications from eligible candidates from its college for the job/workshop based on the format jointly agreed to with ETCPL,

4.0 JOINT RESPONSIBILITIES

- 4.1 The notification for job/workshop shall be released by kalimpong college. (on its notice board and website) after mutual approval by both the parties.
- 4.2 The annual intake of students shall be decided by both the parties jointly.

- **4.3** Both the parties will plan and execute job fairs and various campus interview opportunities online/offline.
- **4.4** Both the parties will plan and execute pre-hire training (PHT) as per the convenience of the college.
- **4.5** Both the parties would have authorized rights to promote each other on social media and various other public platforms.
- **4.6** Both the parties will also take steps to provide training on the promotion of skills that are of local nature.

5.0 MISCELLANEOUS

- **5.1** The Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid for a period of one year from this date and can be renewed for further period on mutual consent provided satisfactory fulfilling of annual intake for both the parties.
- **5.2** Both parties shall have prerogative to terminate this Memorandum of Understanding after giving notice of one month in advance of the date of termination in case of any discrepancy or unavoidable circumstances.
- 5.3 In case of any dispute between the two parties, Kalimpong College and ETCPL will nominate a representative each for resolving the dispute.

AND WHEREAS JSV has already established multiple such training centres (School for Skills: Allied Health Sciences) in West Bengal, Assam, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh and has been running them successfully with high rate of job placement from among rural poor youth over last ten (10) years.

AND WHEREAS JSV has been mandated by the Government of West Bengal to train 2990 students from SC/ST background as rural health workers which is ongoing at all its centres in West Bengal.

AND WHEREAS JSV has been operating and managing a similar centre 'School for Skills: Healthcare & Technology' at Centre for Nanotechnology IIT Guwahati since 2019 through an agreement with IITG which has demonstrated success in generating employment for disadvantaged youth.

AND WHEREAS JSV has been operating and managing a similar centre 'School for Skills: Healthcare & Technology' at Centre for Rural Development & Technology IIT Indore since 2023 through an agreement with IIT Indore to generate employment for disadvantaged youth.

AND WHEREAS JSV has established Dr. Graham's School for Skills: Allied Health Sciences at Dr. Graham's Homes in September 2022 to create livelihood opportunities among the youth in Kalimpong.

AND WHEREAS JSV and its related organisations have established multiple rural healthcare centres in different villages in West Bengal, Assam and Bihar and have been running them for last five (5) years.

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutually covenant terms and conditions and understanding set forth in this MOU and other good intentions recited which are hereby mutually acknowledged the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS AND PRINCIPLES OF INTERPRETATION.

1.1 Definition

For the purposes of this MOU, in addition to the terms defined in the introduction to this MOU, whenever used in this MOU, unless repugnant to the meaning or context thereof, the following expressions shall have the meanings ascribed below:

1.1.1"Definitive Agreements" shall mean agreements and arrangements in connection thereto as may be agreed upon between the Parties;

1.1.2 "Law(s)" shall mean all applicable laws, by-laws, rules, regulations, orders, ordinances, protocols, codes, guidelines, policies, notices, directions, judgments, decrees or other requirements or official directive of any Governmental Authority or Person acting under the authority of any Governmental Authority and / or of any statutory authority in India, whether in effect on the date of this MOU or thereafter;

1.1.3. "MOU" shall mean this Memorandum of Understanding and all attached Annexure, Schedules, Exhibits and instruments supplemental to or amending, modifying or confirming this MOU in accordance with the provisions of this MOU;

1.1.4. "Parties" shall mean JSV and the Kalimpong College, jointly, and each one of which is individually referred to herein as a "Party";

1.1.5 "Training Program" means training programthat will be offered by JSV and Kalimpong College in the field of Paramedical Sciences.

1.2 Interpretation

In this MOU, except where the context otherwise requires:

1.2.1 Any reference to a Law, statute or provision includes a reference to that Law, statute or provision as from time to time modified, amended or re-enacted or as its application is modified by other provisions and to any repealed statute or statutory provision which it re-enacts (with or without modification) and to any delegated legislation or regulation made under its terms;

1.2.2 References to a particular recital, article or annexure shall be a reference to that recital, article or annexure in or to this MOU;

1.2.3 In this MOU, the headings are inserted for ease of reference and shall wherever necessary be used to define, interpret or limit any of the provisions of this MOU; and

1.2.4 Words importing the singular shall include the plural & vice versa and references to natural persons shall include bodies corporate & vice versa. Any reference to third party shall mean any person or entity other than a Party to this MOU or an affiliate of such Party.

2. SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 Scope

Collaboration between JSV and Kalimpong College to impart high quality paramedical education and create employment opportunities especially for the students of Kalimpong College.

2. Students of Kalimpong College or recommended by Kalimpong College will get 10% discount in the course. All the aspirants will be recommended by Authorized Signatory of Kalimpong College.

2.2 Objectives

The objective of this MOU between JSV and Kalimpong College is to train a larger number of youth as AHP/Community Health Workers especially among scheduled caste, scheduled tribe youth with special emphasis on women.

2.4 Duties, Responsibilities and Scope of JSV

3.1 Confidentiality

- 3.1.1 All commercial and other information, whether written, oral or in any other form, furnished by one Party to the other or its employees, representatives or agents shall be considered confidential by the receiving Party, which shall take all necessary precautions to keep the confidential information, secret and confidential.
- 3.1.2 The receiving Party shall not, without prior written consent of the other, disclose or allow to be disclosed, such confidential information to any one, except to its relevant officers and employees and only to such extent as may be necessary for the performance of its obligations under this MOU.
- 3.1.3 Notwithstanding the forgoing, this Article shall not apply to information which:
- (i) Is or becomes publicly known or is printed in a publication available to the general public through no wrongful act of the Party concerned; or
- (ii) Is at the time of disclosure already known by the person to whom disclosure is made unless such knowledge is subject to a restriction as to use or disclosure imposed on such a person; or
- (iii) Is acquired from a third party in good faith and without an obligation of confidence being owed to that third party in respect thereof; or
- (iv) Is required to be disclosed by any Party in performance of its obligations arising under this MOU or by any applicable law, or the rules of any stock exchange within or outside India of which it is a member or the rules or regulations of any applicable governmental, quasi-governmental or self-regulating authority binding upon the relevant Party for time being (whether or not having force in law).

3.2 Public Announcement.

3.2.1 Neither Party shall make or cause to be made any public announcement of, or in relation to the existence of this MOU or the intention of entering into Definitive Agreements without the prior written approval of the other Parties.

4. INDEMNITIES

The Parties undertake to indemnify and keep each other indemnified against any losses, damages, liabilities, suits, proceedings, actions, costs etc. incurred, suffered or instituted as a result of non-compliance with or breach of the undertakings and representations made herein

5. Termination

- (i) Either party will have the option to terminate the agreement with a notice period of one
- (1) month in the event the other party fails to discharge its responsibilities satisfactorily. Provided, however, in the event a notice is given by either Party for a breach of the terms of this MOU the Party against whom the notice may be given shall within 45 days cure the said breach and only in the event of a failure to cure the said breach the notice of termination will take effect.
- (ii) Notwithstanding what is stated in the preceding sub clause, under no circumstances such notice should in any way jeopardize the running of a Training Program and it will be ensured that the notice shall take effect only upon the conclusion of a Training Program and the notice shall be deemed to have been extended to be co-terminus with the Training Program.

6. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

6.1 Governing Law

This MOU shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India.

6.2 Dispute Resolution

Any and all disputes or claims arising under this MOU or out of or in connection with the execution, interpretation, performance, or non-performance of this MOU or any or all of the foregoing shall be solely and finally settled by arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. All arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in the English language. Such arbitration shall be conducted in Guwahati in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Judgment upon any arbitral award rendered hereunder may be entered in any court having jurisdiction, or application may be made to such court for a judicial acceptance of the award and an order of enforcement, as the case may be.

7. MISCELLANEOUS.

7.1 Notices

Any communication, notice, letters or documents sent by one Party to the other shall be in English and delivered at the address stated above or at such other address notified in writing to the other Party. The communication, notices etc. may be sent by mail, personal delivery and where sent by e-mail, fax or any other recognized mode (whether electronic or otherwise) it must be backed with Registered A/D communication /courier receipt for valid service. The communication, notice etc. shall be deemed to have been delivered:

- (i) When sent by registered mail three (3) days from the date of dispatch;
- (ii) When personally delivered on delivery of the same at the address of the Party; and
- (iii) When sent by fax/e-mail upon receipt of confirmation.

7.2 Intellectual Property Rights

Save and except as contemplated under the business arrangements between the Parties, nothing in this MOU confers any right upon one Party to use the other Party's intellectual property.

7.3 Entire Agreement

This MOU supersedes all prior arrangements, proposals, agreements and understandings between the Parties whether written or oral in this regard. This MOUor any part thereof can only be amended or supplemented by an instrument in writing signed by each of the Parties hereto and making specific reference to this MOU.

7.4 Survival

The articles pertaining to confidentiality, public announcement, indemnity, governing law and arbitration shall survive termination of this MOU.

7.5 Assignment

Except with the consent of a Party, neither Party shall assign, novate or otherwise transfer all or any of its rights or obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other Party.

7.6 Partnership

Nothing in this MOU shall constitute any of the Parties as a partner of the other, nor shall the execution and implementation of this MOU confer on any Party any power to bind or impose any obligations on the other Party.

7.7 <u>Costs</u>

Each Party shall bear its own expenses and costs with regard to this MOU

7.8 Counterparts

This MOU may be executed in two (2) counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which will constitute one and the same instrument.

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to promote academic linkages between the two institutions and facilitate their development of mutual collaborative programmes that will enhance the intellectual life of both institutions, contribute to increasing cooperation, and promote mutual understanding. Thus, Kalimpong College and Government General Degree College at Pedong, hereinafter individually referred to as "The Party" and jointly referred to as "The Parties" have agreed to the following.

Article 1

OBJECTIVE OF COLLABORATION

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to collaborate with each other in educational projects in areas of mutual interest.

Article 2

The Parties agree to implement collaborative programmes including but not limited to the following programmes:

- a. Online/offline sharing of innovative ideas in Teaching-Learning and e-Governance,
- b. Student mobility.
- c. Organizing seminars//symposia through offline mode.
- d. Sharing of scientific information on areas of mutual interest.
- e. Sharing of resources (online and reading room facilities of the library)
- f. Academic Quality based collaboration like faculty exchange programme/ Invited lectures.

Article 3

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

Involvement of funds, if required, under this Memorandum of Understanding will be subjected to approval of relevant authority/authorities.

Article 4

LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

- 1. The parties agree to implement the programmes stated in Article 2 at Kalimpong College and Government General Degree College, Pedong.
- 2. Any changes of the location of the programme shall be mutually agreed upon by the parties.

Article 5

MODE OF CONDUCTING THE PROGRAMME:

The Programme may be conducted in blended mode (offline/online)

Article 6

CONFIDENTIALITY AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) PROTECTION

Both the institutions shall respect and retain confidentiality in each/any of the collaborative efforts, and all collaborative academic exercises shall be guided, directed and impelled by the greater academic interest of both the colleges and not any other/commercial interest.

This MOU will respect Intellectual Property Right, and any intellectual matter developed by the collaborative efforts of the two institutions shall be retained by them.

Article 7

DURATION AND TERMINATION

- 1. The MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- 2. The MOU shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years, and may be extended for another one(1) year by the mutual written consent of the parties.
- 3. Either party may terminate the MOU at any time by giving written notice to the other party on its intention to terminate this MOU at least six months prior to the date of the termination.
- 4. The termination of the MOU shall not affect the completion of any project/s and programme/s in progress and not completed at the time of termination.

Article 8

AMENDMENT

- 1. The MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the parties and such amendments shall form an integral part of the MOU.
- 2. Such amendment/s or revision/s shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

Article 9

AMENDMENT

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties.




